

Our Services

Information, Advocacy and Referral

Our friendly and experienced team are available to talk with you and explore different services and programs to best meet your needs.

We provide support to help you to connect and stay connected to your local community.

We assist people to connect with information, advocacy and referral to appropriate services and programs.

We provide practical assistance such as filling out forms, letter or email writing or assistance to negotiate a utility bill payment.

Our service is:

- impartial and non-judgemental,
- culturally sensitive
- confidential and open to all, regardless of age or background.

Emergency Relief

We can help you with food, food vouchers, personal care items, medical costs, travel, practical items, and financial assistance.

Case Work

Our Case Workers are trained to assist people presenting with a range of issues and needing professional assistance. People will have the opportunity to see the same case worker multiple times if required, providing consistent support who understands each individual's situation and particular needs.

Education Support

We provide assistance with school expenses. Support can include assistance obtaining books, uniforms and other equipment for primary and secondary school students.

Utility Bill Assistance

We can support you if you are having trouble paying your utility bills and help you to save money and receive help connecting with your retailer.
